OUR HISTORY

Our history began in 2007 when Rianna Glass was born to Terry and Rosalyn Glass.

In February of 2023, at 15, Rianna started dating a coworker. Near the end of August or beginning of September, now 16-year-old Rianna ended the abusive relationship. In the early morning hours of September 14th, 2023, Rianna and her mother, Rosalyn, were murdered by Rianna's ex-boyfriend.

Rianna's Voice was started by Rianna's grieving father, Terry, with the hope that one day he can help a teenager get out of a bad relationship and spare a family from going through the same heartbreak he and his family had to endure.

WHO WAS RIANNA?

Rianna was a junior in high school at the time of her murder. She was studying hard, hoping to attend DeSales University after graduating high school to study in their Family and Marriage Services program and then attend law school. Her dream was to become a family lawyer.

She spent several years dancing at the 3D Dance Studio in Northampton during her youth. She also played a few years of softball at Moore Township Athletic Association and a few more for the PA Outlaws Fastpitch. Not only was Rianna an avid and amazing dancer, but she was also a remarkable softball player. Rianna was also a very hard worker. She worked for Dunkin' Donuts on MacArthur Road, where she had several friends, and many of her regulars became friends along the way.

She left behind her father, Terry, stepmother, Amber, older sister, Serenity, and younger brother, Hunter, along with several grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.

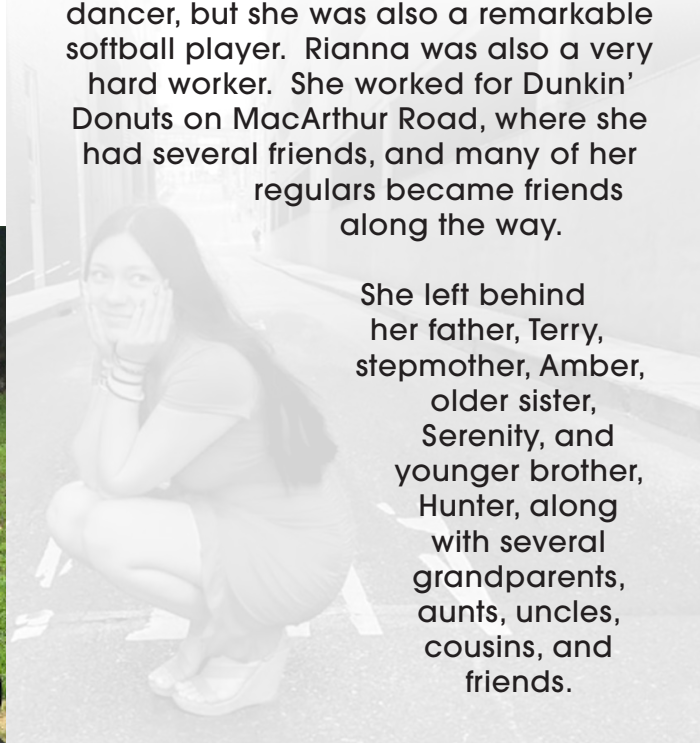
WHO ARE WE?
